

Max height: 20 m



Leaves

- Simple, narrow, sharp
- Yellow-green to green
- Leathery
- Juvenile leaves are longer and broader than adult leaves



Male trees

- Produce small cones with pollen
- Cylindrical
- 10-25 mm long
- Clusters of up to 5 on a common stalk



Where to plant



forest



shrubland



wetland



riparian

Female trees

- Produce red berry-like fruit
- Seed located at tip
- Seed is green
- April to May
- Eaten by birds



Foundation species – *plant first*
Southland species – *plant local*
