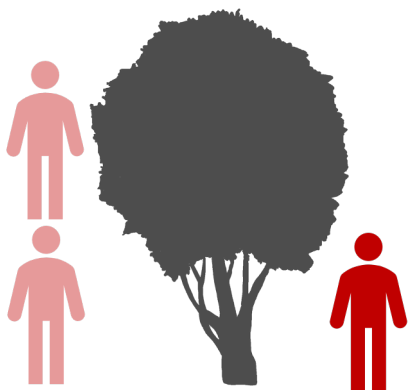

riparian

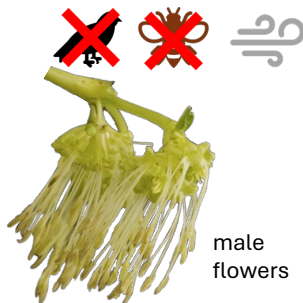
Leaves

- Oval
- Smooth shiny surface
- Opposite on stem, in pairs
- Pale main vein



Flowers

- Separate male and female plants
- Flowers are very small and inconspicuous
- Green or white
- Wind pollinated



Fruit/seeds

- Round to oblong
- Orange-red
- In clusters
- Ripen in autumn
- March to April
- Eaten by birds
