


Mingimingi

Form

Bushy shrub with wide-angled branches

Where to plant



forest



shrubland



wetland



riparian

Leaves

- Narrow shape
- 4-10mm long
- 2-3mm wide
- Opposite on stem, in clusters
- Dark green on top, paler underneath



Flowers

- Separate male and female plants
- Flowers are very small and inconspicuous
- Wind pollinated



male flowers

Fruit/seeds

- Small, round
- Distinct translucent blueish fruit
- 7mm diameter
- Ripen in autumn
- March to April
- Eaten by birds
