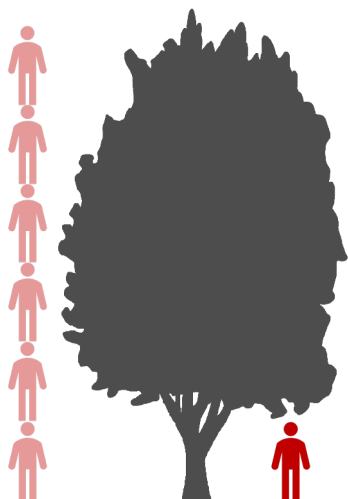

Max height: 12 m



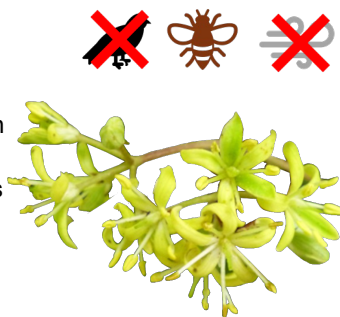
Leaves

- Light green
- 5 – 10 cm long
- Oblong with wavy edges
- Pale mid vein
- Lemony smell when crushed



Flowers

- Small
- Yellow or cream
- Sweet scented
- In large clusters
- October



Where to plant



forest



shrubland



wetland



riparian

Fruit/seeds

- Capsules – 5-6 mm wide
- Capsules split open
- Black sticky seeds
- Fruiting from October to January
- Dispersed by birds
