


Kōhūhū (Black Mapou)

Where to plant




Leaves

- Light green
- 2 – 4 cm long
- Oblong
- White mid vein



Flowers

- Small
- Dark red or purple
- Singular
- Sweet scented at night
- October



Fruit/seeds

- Capsules – 12 mm wide
- Capsules split open
- Black sticky seeds
- Fruiting from January to March
- Dispersed by birds
