Come along to Southland Community Nursery and meet Kelly Crawford this is a great opportunity to learn from a expert weaver. Kelly Crawford started learning the traditional art of Harakeke (Flax) weaving in Papaioea (Palmerston North) and then completed her Bachelor in Level 7 Raranga in Te Kuiti under Te Wananga o Aotearoa.


At this workshop you will learn the basic techniques of Harakeke weaving and gain an understanding of traditional Māori practices associated with the harvesting and preparation of Harakeke, this tradition that has been passed down though many generations and is a great skill to learn and this is a great opportunity not to be missed!

You learn to harvest and prepare Harakeke and make your very own Waikawa (large container) Kono (4 corner basket) Konae (2 corner basket) Whirimekameka (Head band) to take home. This workshop is a level 3, if participants are keen to continue there may be the opportunity to continue learning, up to level 6 with follow up workshops this is depending on the level of interest.
