Class Description

This fun and interactive 2 day workshop will focus on making your own hand-coloured lino cut prints.

Drawing inspiration from the environment around the education centre, we will be producing a small limited edition of hand-coloured prints using Lino and watercolour.

Lino is a versatile and very effective printmaking medium which is easy carve and print.

All aspects of carving and hand printing using a variety of methods will be covered. We will be hand rubbing our blocks so that you can continue your printmaking journey at home. Various techniques in watercolour will also be demonstrated.

This workshop is suitable for those with some printmaking experience and beginners.

Materials to bring

Drawing materials

- Watercolour paints or inks if you have them (Some will be available for use in class if you have none)
- Ruler
- Woodblock carving tools if you have them or other instruments that can create an indentation into Lino (These will be available if you have none)
- Alternative papers to print and experiment with (optional – paper will be provided)
- Spatulas for mixing inks if you have them
- Printing rollers if you have them
- Light weight gloves for carving if you have sensitive skin



- Spoon for hand rubbing the backs of your prints
- Old Shirt or printing apron
- Rags

Facilities and equipment available

- Inside venue with good light and clean tables and chairs
- Access to a landscape view not too far away from the venue setting
- Access to water and containers for holding water for painting
- Magnifying glasses if needed

Jo is an Master of Fine Arts graduate from the Otago School of Art (2000), and also holds a Graduate Diploma in Plant and Wildlife Illustration (NSW Australia 1995), along with a series of scholarships and awards - including the William Hodges Fellowship awarded to the artist in 2000.

She has exhibited extensively in New Zealand and in several group shows internationally. Her work is held in public and private collections throughout New Zealand. Jo has also completed a number of large scale commissions for The Otago Museum, The Nelson Provincial Museum and The Department of Conservation.

Her work is primarily concerned with issues of conservation and ecology. Jo currently works full time on her art and lives in Sumner, Christchurch with her husband and two dogs.
